# A LETTER FROM CHARLEY & MARTIE ELGIN

Well, the Lord has the Elgin's on the move again. I guess 2 years rest is all we needed. Martie and I are moving to Texas to join in the recovery effort there. God moved quickly this time, but has been providing every step of the way. We are selling our



home and one vehicle. When we are on mission we must be unencumbered with "stuff". Many of you know that from our past. We have loved our time at Gateway and will miss you. God has shaped us to go to the "hard" When He says "GO," we go. As Pathfinder Mission, we will partner with Clearpoint Church in Pasadena, Texas, along with several other local churches that want to reach out to the people who have lost their homes to Hurricane Harvey. Our role will be similar to what we did for 5 years in Mississippi, hosting volunteers, working with clients, and managing the reconstruction of their homes. At this point we expect to be in Texas 2 to 3 years. We met with the church elders to share our decision on September 27. Sorry that we won't be able to stay to say goodbye to everyone properly on Sunday. We hope that this letter will suffice as a substitute. We will certainly be back to give you a report at some point in the future.

When you see them, let the twins know that they are loved and appreciated. Pray for the work in Texas. We need wisdom and stamina for the days ahead. It will not be easy, but God is faithful and can do more than we can ask or think. Pray for Martie and me. Leaving family is never easy, but it is required of us. What the Lord requires of us is difficult, but we know that through our obedience He will be glorified. Pray for the people in Texas. That they will not just look around, but they will look up! That their hearts will be tender toward the Gospel and many will come to Jesus in the aftermath of this calamity. God Bless You All. We thank God for Gateway and for each of you. We love you.
