HAITI MISSION

This summer, a team of fourteen people from Gateway will be headed to Haiti from July 14 -21 to partner with Pastor Marc in the mountain region of Bossier.



We will be leading Vacation Bible School in the morning and a crusade each night. One of the highlights of our trip each year is to see the way that God is working to use Pastor Marc to grow the kingdom.

HOW GOD IS MOVING IN HAITI

Here is a recent update from Pastor Marc to give you a glimpse of how God is working in Haiti...

"God is at work. Yesterday morning I had a dream - I saw a voodoo priest who invited me to pray with him. Then he burned a lot of things he used for his voodoo activity.

In the afternoon I shared the dream to some brothers and sisters. Today, I received a call from the biggest voodoo priest in Laporte. He asked me to come and pray with him as he needs to be saved. Hallelujah! I took some brothers and sisters with me (pastor Nicolas went with us also) to go to Laporte. The voodoo priest prayed to receive Jesus. Then he burned all his things that have been in three houses. The last thing we burned was the temple of the devil, a big and nice house (bloc and sheet metal). I understand we burned things that might cost thousands of dollars. We went there at 5:30, we left almost 11 PM under a big rain.

When we burned the temple, his phone rings, a client from USA called him to ask him to do something for her. He said to the client: "I'm a new creature now, the best thing I can do for you is to offer you Jesus." Then he gave me the phone. I talk to her about Jesus. She was very surprised to that news. I'm so thankful to be the servant of God."

Let's regularly pray for Pastor Marc and the work God is doing through him in Haiti. Specifically this week, we are asking the body to pray for Marc and his wife Beatrice as they continue to lead the ministry. They also are desiring to start a family and have been praying for God to grant them that blessing for several years.

Also, consider coming to our missions lunch on Sunday, June 11. It is a great way to financially support our upcoming trip.
